Neema - COCA

A recent study has shown that 60% of Grade 4 children in South Africa are not able to read basic English, which is causing many of them to fall behind in their other subjects too. 'Gateway into Reading' is a syllabus created by the Neema Foundation. It is designed to help children with foundational reading, developing skills in word recognition and deciphering. Our hope is that through running individual and group tutoring we will be able to help many children grow in confidence and become better equipped for their academic future. COCA runs this course simultaneously in KwaCutshwayo Primary School and Durban Children's Home.

Paradigm Shift - COCA

COCA has partnered with Paradigm Shift to support and educate local entrepreneurs with a four-fold program that includes: business training, mentorship, discipleship, and microloans. In June 2016, we had our first set of graduates from the Module 1 course. Some entrepreneurs saw up to a 300% increase in profit as a result of the program. As we continue to run Paradigm Shift we hope to see many aspiring business men and women in our community empowered to grow their businesses and learn biblical principles for life and work. We would love more entrepreneurs as we continue to run courses into 2017 and the future - as well as facilitators and mentors!

Missionary trips to Lesotho

Many different teams are sent to Lesotho throughout the year for various purposes, such as sharing the Gospel and praying for/with the community, but also to drop off donations such as clothing, food, blankets and school bags.
